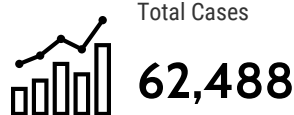
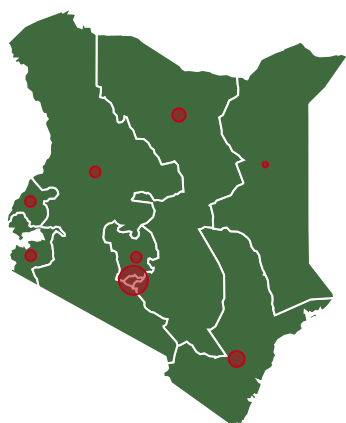

Essential Travel Information

	Emergency Declaration	Yes
	Easing Social Distancing	Social distancing measures are still in effect when out in public
	Stay at Home Order	Lifted, nightly curfew hours are from 11:00 pm to 4:00 am
	Large Gathering & Event Restrictions	> 50 People Prohibited
	Visa Application for Foreign Travelers	Visa application by a foreign national or traveller open
	Airport Operation	Fully operational
	Mandatory Quarantine for Travelers	The traveller does not have a body temperature above 37.5°C (99.5°F) or a persistent cough, difficulty breathing or other flu-like symptoms. A negative PCR-based COVID-19 test conducted within 96 hours of arrival is required for entry. A 14-day quarantine may be required.
	Ground Transportation	Public transportation is operating with social distancing protocols in effect, including mandatory mask wearing
	Hotels, Convention Centers & Event Venues	Hotels and establishments are open for business
	Bar & Restaurant Restrictions	Dine-in services are open with health protocols and social distancing measures in place.
	Park & Museum Closures	Open
	Additional Information	Face coverings are mandatory when out in public
