A negative PCR-based COVID-19 test conducted within 96 hours of arrival is required for entry. A 14-day quarantine may be required.
	Ground Transportation	Public transportation is operating with social distancing protocols in effect, including mandatory mask wearing
*****	Hotels, Convention Centers & Event Venues	Hotels and establishments are open for business
	Bar & Restaurant Restrictions	Dine-in services are open with health protocols and social distancing measures in place.
