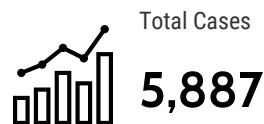
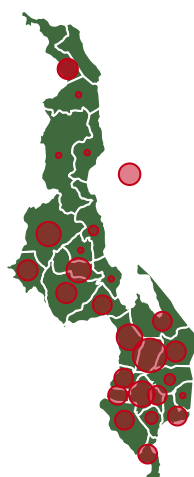

| | Mandatory Quarantine for Travelers | Travelers who are symptomatic and have a travel history to mainland China, Iran, South Korea, the United Kingdom, Japan, Norway, the United States, South Africa, Seychelles, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Namibia, Tanzania or any of the countries in the European Union in the preceding 14 days are taken to an isolation room at the airport for further medical investigation. |
| | Ground Transportation | Public transportation is operating with social distancing protocols in effect, including mandatory mask wearing |
| | Hotels, Convention Centers & Event Venues | Hotels and establishments are open for business |
| | Bar & Restaurant Restrictions | Dine-in services are open with health protocols and social distancing measures in place. |
| | Park & Museum Closures | Open |
| | Additional Information | Face coverings are mandatory when out in public |
