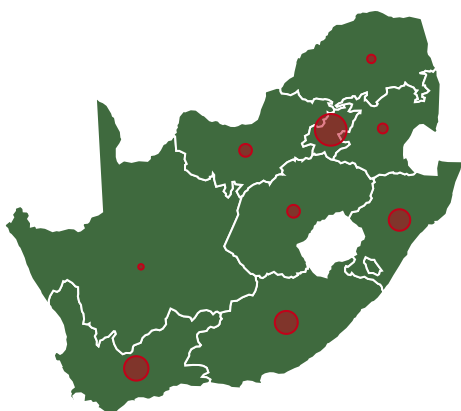

Essential Travel Information

	Emergency Declaration	Yes
	Easing Social Distancing	Social distancing measures are still in effect when out in public
	Stay at Home Order	Lifted
	Large Gathering & Event Restrictions	Indoor gatherings are limited to less than 250 people and outdoor gatherings to 500 people.
	Visa Application for Foreign Travelers	Visa application by a foreign national or traveller from a high-risk country will not be approved
	Airport Operation	Operating
	Mandatory Quarantine for Travelers	On arrival, travelers will need to present a negative COVID-19 test result not older than 72 hours from time of departure. Where a traveler has not done a COVID-19 test prior to departure, they will be required to remain in mandatory quarantine at their own cost.
	Ground Transportation	Public transportation is operating with social distancing protocols in effect, including mandatory mask wearing
	Hotels, Convention Centers & Event Venues	All hotels and establishments are closed with exceptions made for business travelers
	Bar & Restaurant Restrictions	Dine-in services are open with health protocols and social distancing measures in place
	Park & Museum Closures	Open
	Additional Information	Face coverings are mandatory when out in public
