	Visa Application for Foreign Travelers	Visa application by a foreign national or traveller open
	Airport Operation	Fully operational
	Mandatory Quarantine for Travelers	All travelers whose countries or airlines require them to provide negative testing for COVID-19 as a condition for traveling will be required to present a certificate on arrival. Travelers from other countries with symptoms and signs related to COVID-19 infection will undergo enhanced screening and may be tested on arrival.
	Ground Transportation	Public transportation is operating with social distancing protocols in effect
	Hotels, Convention Centers & Event Venues	Hotels and establishments are open for business
	Bar & Restaurant Restrictions	Dine-in services are open with health protocols and social distancing measures in place.
	Park & Museum Closures	Open
	Additional Information	Face coverings are recommended when out in public.
